Dr. Shankle oversees the company's research and product development and many aspects of clinical studies. He co-founded the Alzheimer's Clinic at the University of California, Irvine in 1987 and served as its medical director for 10 years. Following that endeavor, he initiated a community based dementia program, the Shankle Clinic, in 1997. In 2001, Dr. Shankle received the Alzheimer's Association's most prestigious honor, the Zenith Fellows Award, given annually to an independent researcher with a substantial personal commitment to the advancement of Alzheimer's disease research. His findings on human brain development were reported by The New York Times (January 4, 2000) to be one of the most important scientific discoveries of the 1990s. In 2004, he co-authored "Preventing Alzheimer's Disease" published by Putnam Press. Dr. Shankle maintains an academic career as a research fellow of cognitive science at the University of California, Irvine. He also holds additional responsibilities as a member of the grant review committee for the National Alzheimer's Association and a board member of Council on Aging Orange County, and services as a scientific advisor for various pharmaceutical and other healthcare companies. Dr. Shankle received his bachelor degree in biology from Stanford University and his MD from Brown University. He trained as a statistician at the University of Southern California with postgraduate studies at Harvard, as an internist at Cook County Hospital, and finally, as a neurologist at LA County/USC Medical Center.
