Company Overview

Medical Care Corporation is a privately held, neuroinformatics company, founded in Irvine, California in 1999. The company specializes in developing technologies for the precise measurement and monitoring of cognitive performance. Using advanced statistical analysis on a large clinical database, combined with sophisticated data mining techniques, the company has developed a proprietary methodology for the early identification of memory loss, and for the differentiation between memory loss due to normal aging and memory loss caused by underlying medical conditions.

Medical Care Corporation's large base of clinical data fuels the company's innovative R&D efforts. It is from this rapidly expanding resource that new analytical methods are refined, pragmatic assessment tools are developed for clinicians and researchers, and evolving knowledge about patient care is disseminated to the nation's healthcare professionals.

The company's flagship product, the MCI Screen, is the most precise memory assessment tool cited in the medical literature. It enables physicians to distinguish between subtle memory loss due to normal aging and memory loss due to underlying medical conditions with 97% accuracy. This enables early intervention, which improves patient care and promotes wellness in an aging population.

Alzheimer's Disease Overview

Alzheimer's disease is the leading cause of memory loss and dementia with one in 10 individuals over 65 and nearly half of those over 85 are affected. With the aging of the baby boomers and the continued rise in the life expectancy of individuals in industrialized countries, the incidence of the disease will increase significantly in the coming years. Lasting a decade or more from the onset of symptoms, Alzheimer's disease robs individuals of their independence, caregivers and family members of their time and health, and costs the nation more than \$100 billion per year. Currently there is no cure for Alzheimer's disease, however; treatment can delay the progression of the disease by more than 50% enabling individual to live independently for several additional years compared to those who are untreated. Although treatment is most effective when begun early, up to 95% of diagnoses are not made until the disease has progressed to an advanced stage and significant brain damage has occurred.
